Can you take power banks on American Airlines?

Rules and Regulations Yes, you can take power banks on American Airlines flights, provided you take them in your carry-on and pack them in separate plastic bags. There are some restrictions when it comes to their capacity, however:

How many watts a battery can you bring on a plane?

They're limited to a rating of 100 watt hours (Wh) per battery. With airline approval, you can bring two larger spare batteries (up to 160 Wh). Here are our favorite battery packs that are within the FAA and TSA's rules so you can keep your smartphone, tablet, laptop or headphones juiced up during long airplane rides.

Chargers between 101-160 Wh are allowed with airline approval, and any above 160 Wh are prohibited. Always check the watt-hour rating on your charger before flying.

Maximum Allowed Battery Capacity: 100Wh (or up to 160Wh with airline approval) The FAA provides detailed guidelines on the conditions for allowing batteries on board.

In summary, American Airlines permits two battery packs of up to 100 watt-hours in carry-on luggage without

special approval, while those between 100 and 160 watt-hours ...

Select battery packs are approved by TSA for travel in your carry-on bag. It's important to note you're not allowed to pack battery packs in your checked bag.

How do I determine a lithium-ion battery's watt hours (Wh) rating? A lithium-ion battery's Wh should be marked on the battery; if not, you will need to determine the Wh.
