



Battery tender solid red

What does a battery tender indicator light mean?

Flashing red: not charging battery
Solid red: battery charging
Flashing green: battery greater than 80 percent charged
Solid green: monitoring charged battery

What does a red light on a battery tender mean?

If both the red and yellow lights appear on the battery tender, it indicates the battery is defective. A defective battery is a result of corroded battery terminals or sulfated batteries. The best way around this problem is to have the battery pack fixed by a professional.

How do I fix a red light on battery tender plus?

Disconnect all loads from battery (or battery from vehicle), then reattach Battery Tender PLUS. Wait no more than 3 seconds for solid red light. Red light keeps flashing. Charger is not properly connected to the battery: rings or clamps are hooked up backwards.

How many volts does a battery read before attaching a tender?

The battery reads 12.7 volts before attaching the tender. I have a battery on the tender right now. The red light is lit solid. It's been on there several hours. I'm not very electrically inclined, but I would think that 12.7 volts is more than 80% charged and the red light should at least be flashing, if not solid green.

What is a battery tender?

A battery tender is a special charging device that enables your car's battery to charge intelligently. This device is essential, especially for owners who leave their vehicles inactive and batteries at rest for an extended period. Despite its importance, some car owners still do not understand why the device flashes different colors.

How do I know if my Battery Tender is working?

To test if your Battery Tender is working, follow these steps: Plug your Battery Tender into an outlet. Connect the alligator clips to your battery terminals. Check the Battery Tender's LED light status. What do the lights mean on my Battery Tender? The LED lights on your Battery Tender indicate the status of the charging process.

When you connect your battery to the tender and see that red light glowing steady, it means charging is happening. Consider red the universal color for "charging in ...

The Battery Tender may be faulty or not working correctly. To troubleshoot the issue, try connecting the alligator clips to your battery terminals again or try a different battery.
