Beats Solo 2 Wireless Headphones can fail to charge any longer and may only work when connected to a charger. At this point you will need to replace the battery of the headphones. For one thing, although they're still wireless, they lack the W1 chip of the Solo 3 headphones, meaning their wireless connectivity isn't quite as solid. They also don't sound as good, thanks to the improvements to the sound that Beats has made over the years.

Is the Beats Solo 2 a wireless model?

The Wireless model retains the same design of the Solo 2, and that's no criticism. Those cans were molded beautifully, and aside from using some slightly larger cups to account for the battery and built-in controls, all Beats has done differently here is throw in Bluetooth connectivity. Oh, and a power button.

How long do Beats Solo2 Wireless headphones last?

Beats estimates the battery life of the Solo2 Wireless to be roughly 12 hours. Your results may vary depending on your volume levels and the mix of wired versus wireless use. Connecting the audio cable automatically breaks the Bluetooth pairing and powers the headphones down.

How does the Beats Solo2 perform?

The Beats Solo2 is a very solid performer with an easy-to-operate design, powerful bass response, and sculpted, clear highs to balance things out. For Beats headphones, the Solo2 actually sounds slightly dialed back in the bass department--and is all the better for it.
