That means the solid green light signals that your batteries are done charging. It's going to keep shining like in the picture below until you take the batteries out of the charger.

These devices typically feature red, yellow, and green lights; unless the blue light you see is shaped like a battery, and it shows the amount of charge the batteries have attained thus far.
