How much does a solar rebate cover?

This rebate may cover 15 percent to 100 percent of the installation. Installation includes battery storage, or solar and battery storage for residential customers only. Funding will vary by budget for specific program eligibility.

When can I use my solar battery to power my home?

Discharging: You can use the energy stored by your battery to power your home or business when the price of electricity from the grid is more expensive, at night when your solar system isn't producing (if you have solar), or during an outage when you need backup power.

Why do you need a solar battery?

With a battery, you can store that excess solar power yourself. Then, you can use your own stored solar energy in the evening or when electricity rates are high, bypassing the lower NEM 3.0 export rates and maximizing the value of your solar system. SGIP makes adding this battery more affordable.

What is a solar battery & how does it work?

A battery will use stored grid or solar energy to keep your home running when grid power is disconnected. Qualifying customers may have most installation costs covered, allowing your home to be prepared for the unexpected without significant out-of-pocket costs.
