



# Solar lights staying on with new battery

Do solar lights stay on during the day and come on at night?

Solar lights, if they're working properly, should remain off during the day and come on at night. The sunshine charges the lights in the daytime so they have enough 'juice' to stay fully lit when it's dark out. But what do you do if the reverse happens? This begs the question, 'why are my solar lights staying on during the day?'

Why do my solar lights stay lit during the day?

The reason your solar lights are staying lit during the day is likely due to a faulty night reading, often caused by water or dirt getting inside the light and causing it to malfunction. Another reason could be poor wiring which is causing the light to short circuit. And yet a third reason could be a dead or dying battery.

When should I replace my solar light batteries?

If you notice a significant decrease in your solar light's runtime, it's a sign that the batteries are losing their charging capacity. For instance, if your solar light used to work for 10 hours and now it can only stay on for 5 hours even after a sunny day, it's probably time to replace the batteries.

How to make solar powered lights stay on Long in the night?

There are four solutions to make solar powered lights stay ON for long in the night time. I have shared all the four solutions below. The first solution that you can do with your solar lights is replacing lower watt solar panels with higher wattage solar panels.

Why is my solar light not working?

One of the most common reasons why your solar light isn't working is the wire between the solar panel and the battery. This wire is responsible for transferring the generated electricity from the solar panel to the solar battery -- charging it in the process. If this wire is broken, then your batteries won't charge no matter what you do.
